COVID RULES AND REGULATIONS 2020/21

HEALTH

If you have any of the following; a new cough, high temperature, loss of taste or smell:-

DO NOT come to the club.

If you are unwell whatever the symptoms. **DO NOT** come to the club.

If you are in the vulnerable category of people think carefully as to whether or not you should come to the club.

If the government Track and Trace system has advised you to quarantine do not come to the club until your quarantine period ends.

ROLL UPS-BOOKING A GAME

All roll up bookings are on a 2 weekly basis and to be made 7 days in advance *commencing from Friday October 30th*. To book you should be a paid-up member.

Bookings can only be made by via the Rink Booking Folder situated in the Bowls Hall.

Roll up sessions are limited to Saturdays 12.30 pm - 6 pm and Sundays 12.00 pm - 5.30 pm when the Main Club is open.

To play in the **Friday night** roll up / friendly tuition session 6pm to 7.30pm please contact **Paul Allo** on **07518068246**, email: **plba36609@gmail.com**

Club roll-up sessions will be at stated times with a minimum of 2 individuals per rink to help minimise the cost for the heating and lighting. Cost of these sessions is £1.50 per player.

Members should arrive 15 minutes before the session starts. By booking members are agreeing to abide by these Rules & Regulations.

Please ensure you attend your booked roll up session as it could deny other members the opportunity to bowl at that time.

Failure to comply with these rules will mean future access to the club may be denied.

ARRIVING AT THE CLUB

Enter the club via the sports bar entrance - a face covering must be worn. Sanitise your hands. Team leaders are responsible for checking all team players have been included on the sign in sheets in the sports bar. You may use the government track and trace app barcode instead via your mobile phone. Team Leaders will check all Covid rules and protocols regarding sanitising are undertaken for their team. You should come to the club dressed ready to bowl -greys and a bowls top. Casual dress for roll ups is permitted. Chairs will be designated for you to sit on and use to change your shoes and rest during the game. Do not move the chairs or tables. If you arrive at the club after the designated time and the door is locked please follow the path alongside the cricket pitch to the bowls hall fire exit. Knock the door and await someone to let you in.

PROTOCOL AT THE CLUB

Please wear a mask around all area of the club / bowls hall / toilets. You can remove your mask on the bowls carpet within 2 metre distancing or continue to wear a mask if you wish. The changing rooms are not to be used. You can retrieve your bowls from your locker but please follow the one in / one out protocol for the changing room areas. The Main Club toilets near the indoor bowls entrance are available for members to use. Sanitize your hands on entry and then again on exit. Hand driers are provided in the toilet area.

Follow social distancing rules at all times.

The bar will only be in use when the main club is open. You can bring your own drinks / snacks but do not share with others.

LEAGUE PLAY

Please follow the **RULES for PLAY** placed at the end of each Rink.

Rink fees to be placed in the sealable envelopes provided by the Home Skip and placed in the brown Fees box. Each session will be limited to 3 rink Triples games, 2 and a half hour slots. League start times will be:

Monday and Friday at 10.00 am. Tuesday 6.30pm, Thursday 1pm and 6.30 pm. Sunday 6.00pm.

Remember your 2 METRE social distancing when on the rinks. Each rink will have one jack that will be cleaned before and after each session. Jacks can be cast and then centred using the foot. The maximum length of jack has been reduced by 2 metres to ensure social distancing on the rinks. Mats and jacks will be cleaned before and after each session with the wipes at the end of the rink.

Only touch your own bowls, other bowls moved by using your feet. Woods ending in the ditch remain there until the owner removes them or by a player using a cloth or bowls lifter. Home skip uses the scorecard, Away team adjusts the scoreboard and sanitises the switches afterwards Place the scorecards in the relevant boxes at the end of the game.

LEAVING THE CLUB

After the game please leave the club via the main club wearing a mask and observing 1m / 1m plus distancing. Please do your socialising in the car park with appropriate social distancing between you.

SPECTATORS

Spectators may visit the bowling sessions as long as no more than 30 people are in the Bowls Hall. 18 players / 12 spectators will make up the 30 maximum number. All Covid rules and protocol must be adhered to.
